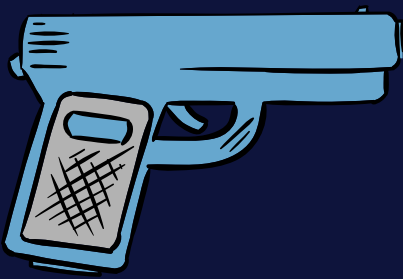
My Plan for North Carolina

AFFORDABLE HEALTH CARE



Prince has been fighting for accessible and affordable health care throughout his career in the health care industry. Prince will expand Medicaid, invest in mental health care, protect consumers from excessive health care cost and surprise bills, address racial disparities in health care, protect women's reproductive rights, and combat the opioid epidemic.

END GUN VIOLENCE



Last year, Fayetteville seen it's deadliest year yet with 48 homicides shattering 2016's homicide record. Fayetteville will continue to reach these heartbreaking milestones so long as our leaders in Raleigh remain mute on gun violence. Prince will support and protect gun and domestic violence victims, and fund gun violence research.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE REFORM



Prince is committed to advancements to North Carolina's criminal justice system including decreasing unnecessary police engagements, Limiting use of deadly and non deadly force, increase diversity in police recruitment, Increase access to body cam footage, decriminalize Marijuana, eliminate license suspensions for unpaid traffic fines, and allow trained mental health professionals to respond to mental health related 911 calls for service instead of police.

EDUCATION & CHILD CARE



Prince will work to ensure our children have access to a quality education, increase teacher pay, and provide access to free community college for NC students.

Lack of access to affordable child care can disrupt a parent's ability to find and maintain work. Prince's plan will expand access to affordable child care, early childhood education programs, and family nutrition benefits.
